- 3 LEGIONELLA SURVEY:

 - The white line on the step into Church has been painted. (for free)
 - Former shed area – there is an offer to allow a trainee architect to use the production of plans for this area as a practice project. This to include the widening of the path around that part of the house.
 - There was an offer of an incinerator bin for the use of our gardener.
 - There is an issue with the overhang of the fir trees. Discussion revolved around the possible need for a new survey before any work is done.
